### **GBI CLOSSES SITE FOR SUNOCO USING BUTANE BIOSTIMULATION TECHNOLOGIES™**

---

Global BioSciences, Inc. (GBI) submitted a Class A-2 Response Action Outcome (RAO) Statement for a Sunoco-owned property located in Massachusetts. The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) assigned Release Tracking Number (RTN) 3-12555 to the Site in June 1995 after a 72-hour reportable condition was discovered. As part of the RAO, GBI conducted a Method 1 Risk Characterization to evaluate risks to human health and the environment. A Risk Characterization prepared for the Site concluded that a condition of *No Significant Risk* exists at the Site. Butane Biostimulation Technologies™ were implemented to remediate a dissolved-phase plume of gasoline and MTBE contamination to below drinking water standards.
